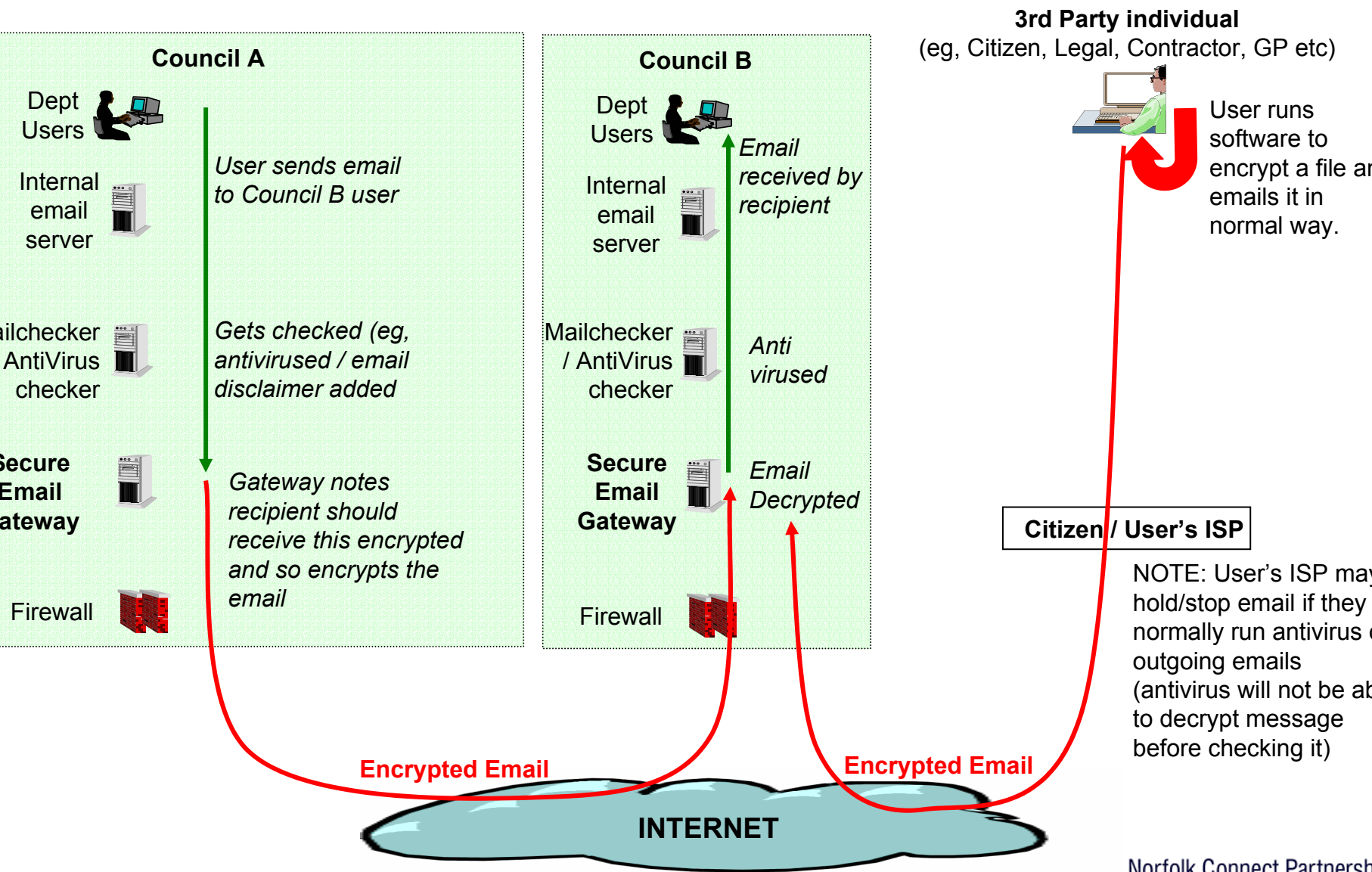

Issues

- Consultation overload
- Consultation duplication
- Consultation clashes
- No single access point for the public to access information about consultation and how to get involved
- Partners developing own solutions

An integrated consultation tool

- Can be accessed through www.norfolkambition.gov.uk.
- That partners can link to.
- That can also run on partners sites in their own livery.
- That allows partners to publish comprehensive details of consultations – past, present and forthcoming.
- That allows members of the public to locate consultations in their area, postcode, by topic or key-word search.

An integrated consultation tool

- That encourages citizens to register for, and be alerted to, consultations of interest to them.
- That enables structured feedback to be published both on consultation results and how they have been used in order to encourage greater participation in the future.
- That brings together information about consultations from all County Strategic Partners to create a searchable archive of consultations, thus avoiding possible duplication of research activity.

An integrated consultation tool

- That has the potential to link to other survey tools to implement the consultative process or access documents or other websites.
- That allows all NCSP to be able to put consultations on the database.
- That allows for new partners to be given access to add consultations.
- That produces management reports, for example to see how many consultations each partner has uploaded, etc.
